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 Allocation funding for 2021: The Recipient received \$7,000,475; in 2022 \$7.3 was awarded represented an increase of \$324,678. This was allocated to set service categories based on the recommendations of the priority-setting process from 2021 (FY 2022).

Standing MPX report

- The TGA has 282 confirmed cases; 81 in the eastern region and 201 in the
 west, impacting those under 40, mostly men, gays, bisexuals, men who
 have sex with men, and transgender. In the western region, 24% are
 PLWH.
- During Oakland Pride and Pridefest, 554 and 103 were vaccinated, respectively.
